



VerbalCheck Pilot Terms

VerbalCheck is an instructional support tool designed to assist faculty in validating student learning through structured analysis of student submissions. The following terms apply exclusively to the limited instructional pilot.

Pilot Scope

The VerbalCheck pilot is limited to designated courses and participating instructors who voluntarily opt in. Use of the system is confined to instructional evaluation and feedback during the pilot period.

Data Collection and Retention

VerbalCheck collects only the minimum data necessary to evaluate student submissions and generate instructional feedback. Data collected during the pilot may include student submissions, AI generated analysis, rubric alignment metadata, and basic system logs. Pilot data will be retained only for the duration of the pilot semester plus up to ninety days for review and reporting. After this period, all identifiable student data will be securely deleted or irreversibly anonymized. Pilot data is not sold, shared, or used for AI model training or commercial purposes.

Instructional Responsibility and Liability

VerbalCheck provides decision support only and does not make final grading, academic integrity, or disciplinary determinations. Instructors remain solely responsible for reviewing all outputs and making final academic decisions. AI generated outputs may contain errors and must be reviewed by faculty prior to use.

Evaluation Basis

The pilot is provided on an evaluation basis to assess instructional value, workflow integration, and faculty experience. No guarantees are made regarding accuracy, availability, or suitability for any specific instructional outcome during the pilot period.
